Prof. Wolfenden is a behavioural & implementation scientist, and the Director of the National Centre of Implementation Science (NCOIS). Luke has previously worked with the UK Cochrane Centre, and The World Health Organization (WHO) and is a Fellow of the Lancet Commission on Obesity.

He has led implementation trials in hospitals, outpatient clinics, schools, childcare centres, community organisations, and sports clubs.

His research seeks to reduce the burden of chronic disease in the community, and has been influential in shaping health service practice and policy across Australia and Internationally.
